

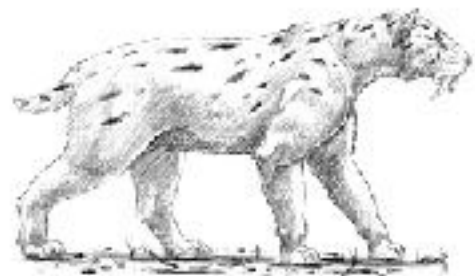

### Directions:

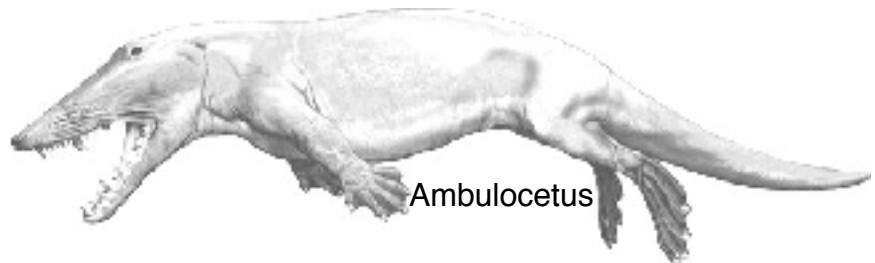
1. Use the packet of Greek and Latin “word stems” to figure out how each animal was named. The first one is done for you. Some of the animals are pictured also.

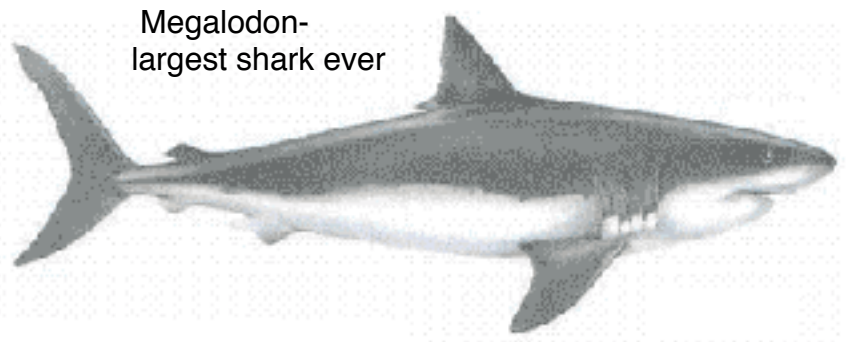

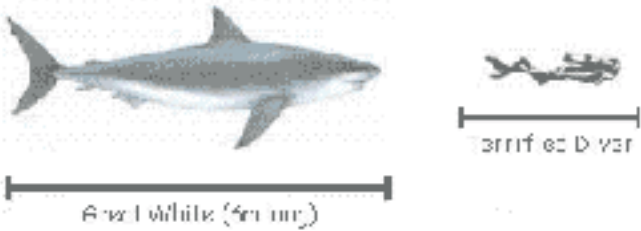

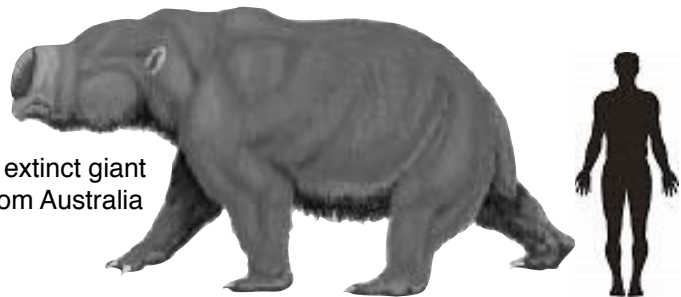

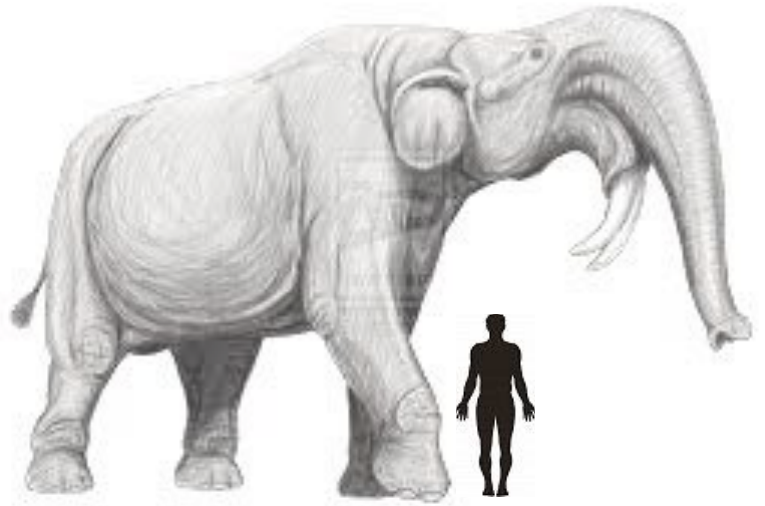
